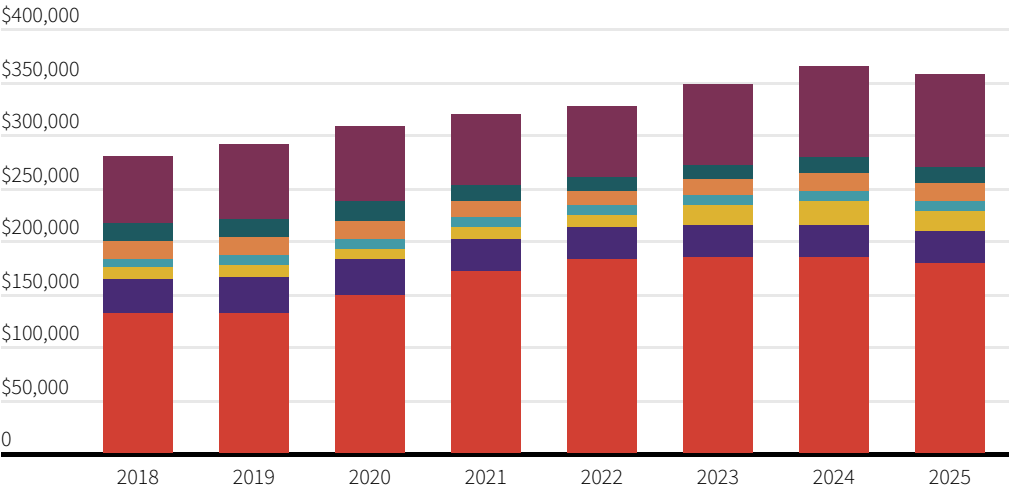

# Annual Volume (x\$1M, 2012\$)

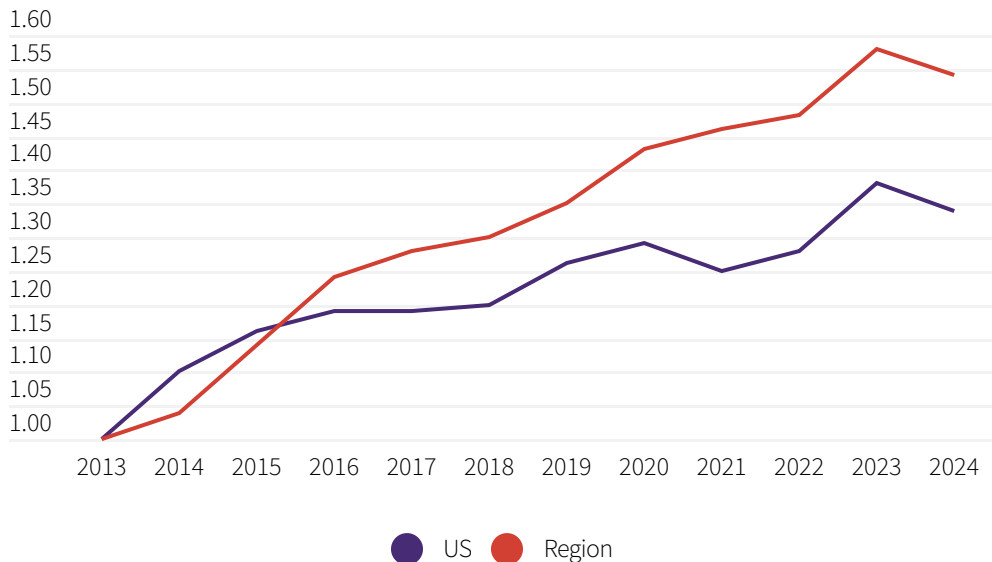

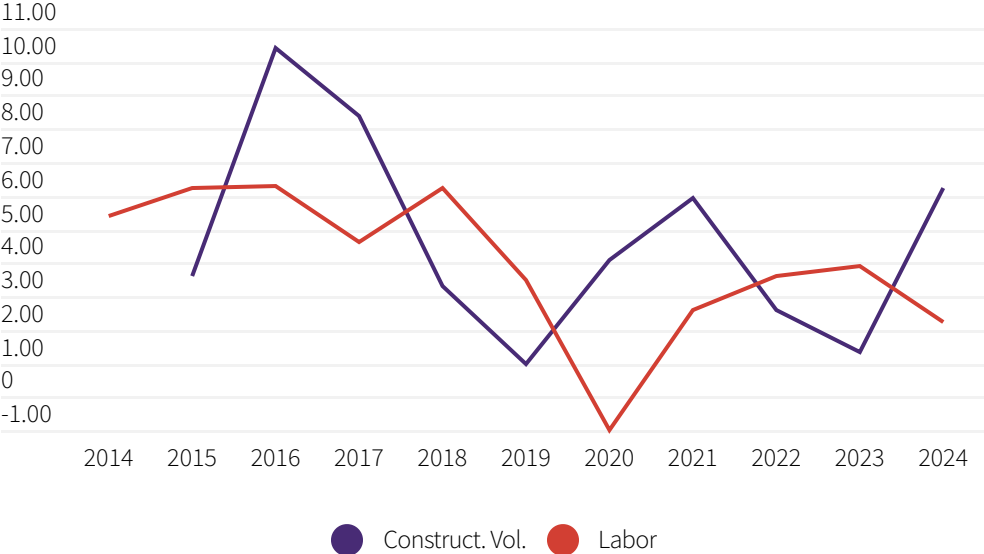
## Regional Construction Employment
